## Inspection of Vessel:

The vessel was found on a boat lift at the owner's private dock which the hull bottom was visible. No damage or scraps were sighted on the bottom. The Hull sides were chalky but no damage was sighted. All the interior cushions were in serviceable condition without any cuts, wear or damage. The boat was clean in and out also looked as if it has been well maintained. The Mercury 5.0 started easily and ran smoothly during the lake test run. No leaks were seen in the engine compartment. No smoke or oily film from the exhaust seen in the water. The engine ran well at all rpms and no usual noises were heard. The drive shifted well and the U-joints, gimbal bearing were not noisy when helm was hard over in both Port and Starboard. The drive did not show any signs of corrosion.

The Safe-T-Alert CO detector inside the cabin did not power on. Fresh water boat.





Chalky hull sides


